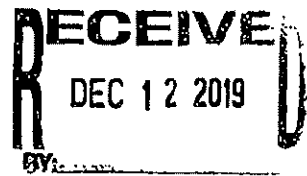



**ORDER ON MAYER BROWN LLP'S MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY  
JUDGMENT AS TO THE RECEIVER'S ENTITLEMENT TO AN AWARD OF  
ATTORNEY'S FEES**

This cause came before the Court on Mayer Brown LLP's ("Mayer Brown") Motion for Partial Summary Judgment as to the Receiver's Entitlement to an Award of Attorney's Fees ("Motion"). Having reviewed the Motion, response, reply, court file, and having heard argument of counsel, it is hereby **ORDERED** that ruling on Mayer Brown's Motion is **DEFERRED**. See *Van Diepen v. Brown*, 55 So. 3d 612, 614 (Fla. 5th DCA 2011) ("[i]t is the party seeking attorney's fees that has the affirmative burden to demonstrate what portion of the effort was expended on the claim that authorized attorney's fees.").

The Court will entertain this issue upon the Receiver's submission of his fee petition with appropriate authority addressing entitlement to attorney's fees.
