

ORDER ON MAYER BROWN LLP'S MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT AS TO THE RECEIVER'S ENTITLEMENT TO AN AWARD OF ATTORNEY'S FEES

The Court will entertain this issue upon the Receiver's submission of his fee petition with appropriate authority addressing entitlement to attorney's fees.
